I leave the camp through the heavy wooden door. I cannot turn around, I do not want to see it anymore. I just want to get on the bus quickly, and not have to talk. I leave my lunch untouched ... And people claim not to have known about that? I cannot accept that millions of Germans allowed themselves to be fooled by a crazy fanatic. When we stood in front of the former cesspit for a moment of silence for those who had been killed or tortured, I felt so helpless that I wanted to cry. I was shocked that thousands of people could be persecuted and butchered because of their race or political beliefs without any serious attempt by their countrymen to intervene. I will certainly need more time to think through these impressions. I would like to apologize for the rotten behavior of so many Germans. But where?
