Chronology

November 1935	In the First Regulation to the Reich Citizenship Law "Jews" are defined in Germany
May 1940	Occupation of the Netherlands
October 1940	Registration of assets of Jews in the Netherlands
January – August 1941	Registration of Jews in the Netherlands
February 1941	Attempt to set up a ghetto in Amsterdam
April – December 1941	Introduction of a waterproof personal ID in the Netherlands
July – September 1941	ID of Dutch Jews are marked with a black stamp "J"
Autumn 1941	Jews are banned from many public places in the Netherlands
April 1942	The yellow star is introduced in the Netherlands
July 1942	Deportations start from Amsterdam
September 1944	Last Deportations
May 1945	Liberation of the Netherlands
